At the end of every decade so far, a conceptual definition has taken shape, a collection of characteristics for which each decade's abbreviation (80s, 90s) subsequently serves and is used as a code. This is just as true for general historical/social events as it is for cultural production, such as in the visual arts. Similarly, in the current decade, which still lacks a more specific, commonly

accepted descriptor and will be over in less than two years, one can, on the basis of current and prior art activities, make out aesthetic trends and movements that presumably will be associated with it in the future. Catchwords: retromodern, romantic conceptualism, new constructivism, crystalline formalism, art-historical sampling, etc. The evening will be an attempt at a critical survey and review of the "noughties", to use an obvious suggestion for naming the decade, and will hopefully provide a look ahead to the "teens" of this still-young century.
